Are you a Student on the MSc in Life Sciences course? Would you like to obtain a Double Degree?

Simply study one additional semester in the *Drug Synthesis and Manufacturing MSc* at UCT Prague and you will obtain **two diplomas**: *MSc in Life Sciences FHNW* and *MSc in Drug Synthesis and Manufacturing UCT Prague*. This combination of degrees is especially helpful for students aiming to pursue a PhD.

Apply for the double degree programme by March 15th preceding the exchange semester to Prof. Dr. Georg Lipps (georg.lipps@fhnw.ch). Selected students will then be asked to submit an application to UCT Prague by July 1st.

Financial Support

Double degree students are eligible for the Swiss-European Mobility Programme (SEMP) and may receive support in the order of CHF 1600 per semester at the UCT Prague.
