


1. Library approval for OA funding via Dashboard *before* author has signed publishing agreement

Research Dashboard Overview






What does the Research Dashboard do?

- Displays article metadata of all accepted core content articles by your corresponding authors;
- Enables institutions to approve or decline articles for funding under the agreement and track the remaining article allocation across the consortia;
- Each tab can be exported as CSV for further analysis and tracking;
- Fully integrated with the author workflow so the author is kept informed of any decision taken by the library.
